




Population


- Main industries: aluminum, coal, petroleum products, chemicals (fertilizer, soap, paints), cement, glass, textiles, tobacco, food processing, beverages

- * Main exports: fish (mainly shrimps and prawns), timber, copra, cashew nuts and citrus, cotton, coconuts, tea and tobacco.









